Judgement Criteria

- **Interpretation of the Topic** – The artwork must effectively capture and convey the essence of the given historical figure, reflecting their values, contributions, or personality.
- **Selection of Materials** – The choice of medium and technique should be suitable, enhancing the overall execution of the project.



- **Originality** – The artwork should showcase innovative expression, offering a fresh perspective on the chosen historical figure.
- **Creativity** – The piece should engage viewers through storytelling, symbolism, and impactful representation.
- **Overall Presentation** – The final artwork must exhibit aesthetic appeal, attention to detail, and a polished, professional finish.
