General Instructions

- Participants are encouraged to write their stories in any genre, based on the given topic.
- Creativity and originality are key in making the story engaging and unique.

- **Word Limit**

Maestros: 200 to 300 words

Trendsetters: 300 to 400 words

Legends: 400 to 500 words

Elites: 500 to 600 words



- Stories must be written in English for the English category and in Hindi for the Hindi category.
- The participants must submit a clear photograph or PDF of the story.
- The topic/question will be shared with schools on the competition day at the allotted time. All entries must be handwritten.
- Please note the entries must be emailed to the Organising Committee within the given deadline.



Judgement Criteria

- **Creativity and Originality** – The uniqueness of the plot, characters, and setting. Fresh ideas and innovative twists in the story.
- **Clarity and Coherence** – Logical flow of the storyline with clear connections between events. Well-structured introduction, body, and conclusion.
- **Character Development** – Depth and relatability of the characters and how well the characters evolve throughout the story.



- **Language and Expression** – Use of appropriate vocabulary, grammar, and sentence structure. Engaging and vivid descriptions that enhance the narrative.
- **Adherence to Theme and Word Limit** – Relevance of the story to the given theme Heritage of India. Adhering to the word limit while maintaining the integrity of the story.
